## **Liner Art Design**

- 1) Graph each line on your paper using pencil. Make sure that your lines are straight by using a good ruler. Extend the lines to the edge of your graphing paper. If you want, you may trim the edges to make it neat.
  - 2) When you finished the graphing lines, color your design to create a stained glass window.
  - 3) You may wish to go over certain parts of the design with a dark pen, crayon, or marker to emphasize different portions.
